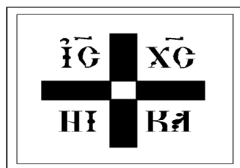

To the Word coeternal with the Father and the Spirit, born of the Virgin for our salvation, let us the faithful give praise and worship. For He will be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to endure death and raise the dead by his glorious resurrection. Page 171.
